



ACCELERATED FREEFALL (AFF)

Accelerated Freefall (AFF) is simply the fastest way to learn to skydive. The course is designed for the individual who wants to progress in the sport with the aim to becoming a qualified Skydiver. Our team of British Parachute Association AFF instructors have over 31,000 skydives logged so you are in great hands!

Situated at Dunkeswell, near Honiton, we are carrying on a proud tradition of sport parachuting at the airfield, which started in 1964. Affiliated to the British Parachute Association we are setting the standard for safety, ensuring that you can enjoy the most exhilarating, breathtaking, adrenalin pumping moment of your life with complete confidence.

What happens on the day?

Our AFF Courses start at 08.30am where you will meet your instructor. Before you can make your first skydive – we will teach you how! You will receive a minimum of 6 hours ground tuition, covering the safety aspects, the equipment you will use, how to exit the aircraft, control in freefall and how to fly and land your parachute. There is then a multiple choice test that you will be expected to pass. On completion of the ground tuition, you will have the skills and knowledge needed to make you a safe and confident first time skydiver. Your jump will then take place on the next jumpable day.

The jump!!

Your first jump will take place from an altitude of 15,000 feet. You will exit the plane accompanied by two instructors who will guide you in freefall as you accelerate to 120 mph. You will freefall up to 2 miles before you deploy your own parachute at 5,000 feet above the ground. You will then fly your parachute (with radio assistance) as you glide in to land.

Progression

Our dedicated BPA approved AFF Instructors will coach you through the British Parachute Association Accelerated freefall System to graduation in a minimum of 8 skydives. Then the sky's the limit!!

Booking Terms & Conditions

Deposits/Payments

The deposits and payments are completely non-refundable. Once the date of your jump/s is booked, you are required to give a minimum of 28 days notice to change this date and an admin fee of £25 per person will be charged. If less than 28 days notice is given, you will be required to pay an extra £50 to rebook. Jumpers, who do not show up on the day of their jump / course, for any reason, will be required to pay an extra £50 to rebook. The disbursement of payment for a skydive, covers the following costs: BPA provisional insurance, flight tickets, tuition, freelance tandem instructor, packer and temporary club membership.

Weather: Should the weather be unsuitable for jumping on the day it is your responsibility to return to the parachute centre on another occasion(s) if necessary, to complete your jump. You must rebook within 90 days of each unsuccessful attempt.

Balances: Balances payable on day of jump become non-refundable.

Postponement: We do not accept liability for any costs or expenses incurred if we have to postpone your jump, where the reason for the postponement is beyond our control.

Insurance: All jumpers are covered by the British Parachute Association third party Liability Insurance of £2 million. For personal accident cover, please call the Office or visit www.extremeplus.co.uk.

Medical restrictions

If you have any medical conditions or are aged between 40 and 55, you must consult your GP to sign and stamp the BPA medical form 114-A (i): "Solo Student Parachutist Declaration of Fitness to Parachute". These forms are available on request, from our website, or will be sent to you with confirmation once a booking has been confirmed.

Age restrictions for AFF

The minimum age is 16 years and the maximum age is 55 years. If you are aged between 16 and 18 you must obtain a parent or guardian's consent, on BPA form 106 (Parental Consent).

Important notice

Parachuting is an adventure sport and participation in such sports necessarily involves a risk of injury or death regardless of the standard of training, supervision and equipment employed.

I voluntarily accept all the risks inherent in the sport and I agree for myself and my personal representatives to indemnify and hold harmless Skydive UK Ltd against any claim or claims whether on my own account or from third parties arising out of any accident or incident resulting in any loss or damage (including bodily injury and death).
